

## International Migration Solutions

**Process:** **Obtainment of Cyprus Citizenship by Exception for minor children of the investor**

Original documents to be submitted (unless stated otherwise)	Status
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Letter by the representative of the dependent, clearly explaining under which criterion/ category the application is made</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Application form M126 completed and signed by the parents of the minor children before a Registrar of a Cypriot Court or the Cyprus Consulate Office of the applicant’s country of origin</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>True copy of passport with the main information for each applicant, valid for at least 2 years</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Copy of residence permit in Cyprus (if applicable)</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>2 colour passport size photos in high resolution for each dependant (the photo must be less than 6 months old, 3.5 x 4.5 cm or 4 x 5 cm, full-face view directly facing the camera with a neutral facial expression and both eyes open, taken in front of a plain white or off-white background)</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Apostil/ duly certified* birth certificate for dependents, translated in English or Greek</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Written consent from both biological parents of the child regarding the obtainment of the Cypriot Citizenship by Exception. The consent will have to be signed before a Registrar of a Cypriot Court or the Cyprus Consulate Office of the applicant’s country of origin</li> </ul>	
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Letter from the applicant confirming the dependents are financially dependent to him/her e.g. they do not work or are students or have a disability that makes him/her unable to work</li> </ul>

- Authorization letter to Deloitte to represent the minor children at the Authorities (each parent needs to sign one authorization letter on behalf of their child)

**\*Note:**

*Apostil is a simplified certification of public documents. All countries members of Hague Agreement convention have agreed to accept official documents such as criminal records, marriage and birth certificates only if they are Apostil. Documents destined for use in participating countries should be certified by the relevant authority in the jurisdiction in which the document has been executed. With this certification by the Hague Convention, an Apostil document is entitled to recognition in the country of intended use. These documents must include the official's title and signature in order to be eligible. Normally, the procedure to get the Apostil certification consists of verification from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the country of origin. In case a country is not a member of the Hague Agreement then the required documents need to be signed and stamped by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the country of origin. This stamp must be verified by the Embassy of Cyprus or Consulate Office in the country where the document has been issued.*

**General Comments:**

- The application for the minor children can be submitted upon the obtainment of the Cypriot Citizenship of the main applicant/ investor.
